# Message from Israel 2048 International Board Chairman, Omri Dahan

Dear Friends of Israel 2048,

The State of Israel is, more than anything else, the life's work of the Jewish people.

It is a product of hope and of love. It is a product of hard work and heart work. In addition to the blood, sweat, and tears the Jewish people have shed for Israel, there has been no shortage of words. As anyone who studies its history knows, Israel was founded as a product of dialogue. While it may have been born in its earliest days in Herzl's imagination and longing, it only came to life after deep and pervasive dialogue, spanning several decades and multiple continents. In its earliest years



of life, Israel's fledgling democracy was characterized by fiery orators, clever parliamentarians and eloquent diplomats. To dream, to argue, to work through conflict and confluence, Israel's founders and builders understood innately – perhaps as a reflection of the traditions of Talmud scholars that came before them – that only through dialogue and discussion could they perfect and advance the Jewish nation.

Back then, most could at least agree the singular goal was to create a Jewish state. After 75 years as a state, there has been no diminution of strength in our dialogue, but one does get a sense that maybe we're not all bound by the same singular goal. After all, we have indeed built a strong, secure state.

And yet, as Michael Oren so masterfully elucidates, the Jewish State is at risk from multiple trends that if not addressed, threaten to harden us in our differences rather than coalesce us toward our shared destiny. Even though Israel is blessed with Hashem's protection, we also must play a leading role in ensuring Israel's continuity.

The spiral of history is calling upon us again to reground our dialogue in a new shared purpose: a second century of Israel, one in which we thrive together. When energy is focused, it has a far greater impact. The Jewish people and the State of Israel have a historic opportunity to redirect our collective energy toward a shared future that embodies our best values, our highest selves, and our full potential to positively contribute to humanity.

Michael Oren gives us the blueprint for the dialogue and action we must take. It's time again for us to build and be built, together.

#### 2022: A Year in Review

After many months of intensive research and writing efforts led by Ambassador Michael Oren, we completed our Manifesto 2048: The Rejuvenated State in Arabic, English, and Hebrew. It will be published by Toby Press and available for purchase this spring in time for Israel's milestone 75th anniversary.

#### **Town Hall Tishes**

Following several pilots of our "Town Hall Tish" roundtable model in Tel Aviv, New York, and Oakland (California) we held a vibrant tish in Herzlia in March at the home of Israel 2048 amuta (nfp) members Ariella and Charles Zeloof.





The event brought together leaders from Israel's private sector and touched on themes including sovereignty and Israel-Diaspora relations.

Additional Town Hall Tishes around the theme of "Israel the Nation-State" are planned for 2023 as we embrace new national and global partnerships – helping Israel 2048 reach hundreds of activists passionate about planning for Israel's future. One of these new partnerships is with the "Z3 Future of Zionism" initiative of the Palo Alto JCC. Israel 2048's Eli Ovits was also invited to participate in the 125th anniversary of the first Zionist congress in Basel – bringing together some 1,200 activists from across the world.

We are creating a facilitators' guide, facilitators' training, and a list of issue experts and organizations to accompany the Tish Series. Through this series we aspire to become a launchpad for meaningful policymaking and new student publishers.

#### **Organizational Structure and Strategic Planning**

During 2022, Israel 2048 focused on capacity-building and strategic planning in order to position the organization for sustainable growth. Efforts led by board members Isaac Hassan, Rachel Moore, Warren Mazer and Omri Dahan included:

- Strengthening our Israeli amuta (nfp) and US affiliate "2048 The Second Century"
- Producing our first multi-year plan demonstrating how we will educate and engage young adults and influencers with the ultimate goal of facilitating change
- Undertaking two international development tours to meet stakeholders resulting in seed funding for marketing and core operations

Our leadership came together for a virtual L'chaim to welcome in the new Jewish year and thank all our stakeholders for their ongoing support.

Over the coming months, we will welcome members of our new global advisory board.





#### **Reaching New Audiences**

We launched our bilingual website israelin2048.com enabling Israel 2048 to share content and upcoming activities.

As we embark on our public launch in 2023, a greater emphasis will be placed on digital social media channels as a way of reaching a grass-roots audience and widening our scope of public support.

We will also be distributing online a series of vision essays on Israel's future prepared by a diverse group of Israeli thought leaders. An impressive roster of leaders has been approached, and some have submitted. More are on their way, and we will be including this content in our online engagement in the months to come.

Our first letter to be released is from President Isaac Herzog conveying greetings to Israel 2048 on the launch of initiative.

#### **Z3 Conference**

In December Israel 2048 featured at the Z3 Conference, bringing together some 800 participants from across Israel and the US.

The Z3 Project, an initiative of the Oshman Family JCC in Palo Alto, CA, is dedicated to modeling how Zionism can evolve.





#### Get ready for our upcoming book tours in Israel nd the US!

Following the publication of 2048: The Rejuvenated State in 2023 Michael Oren will be undertaking book tours in Israel and the US.

Israel 2048 will be setting up events in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem where you can hear more about 2048: The Rejuvenated State from its author and engage with its ideas directly.
